

Camp Sunshine Packing List



Your family will be staying in a suite with two twin beds, a set of bunk beds, and a full-sized futon. Each family suite has heat/ AC and includes a full bathroom, mini-fridge, and microwave. One pillow and quilt are provided per bed. If you are driving to camp, we ask that you please bring your own sheets and towels. Cots and portable cribs are available by advance request on your registration form.

Personal Items

Clothing

- Swimsuits: indoor heated pool open year – round
- Casual and comfortable clothing to layer as the temperature fluctuates, including jackets & pants
- Rain gear/ umbrella
- Closed-toe shoes/ sneakers

- Hats & gloves/mittens
- Winter jacket

- Warm socks
- Boots & indoor shoes
- Ice skates (or use ours!)
- Downhill skis/ snowboard/ helmet (or use equipment provided at the mountain)

- Insect Repellant
- Sunglasses
- Baseball hats

- Snacks & drinks
- Quarters, detergent & dryer sheets for washer/ dryers
- Talent show supplies (optional- this is your chance to be a star! Music, props, etc.)
- Costumes for the Masquerade Party (or raid our costume closet!)
- Extra pillows/ blankets
